## WHAT IS MAINSTREAMING?

## UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities:

Encourage promotion and participation of people with disabilities in mainstream sporting activities at all levels.

Interpretation: Organisation and implementation is different on a national basis and indeed a sport by sport basis BUT prevailing trend is for the management of disability sport to be 'transferred' to the equivalent mainstream sport organisation.

## WHAT IS MAINSTREAMING?

Mainstreaming is the process of a mainstream sports organisation taking over the responsibility of the management of disability sport.

This process may include becoming responsible for the management of inclusion and integration actions.


United Nations; International Sport
Confederations; International Sport
Federations; National Sport Federations; National Funding Organisations.

Those responsible for managing or implementing the mainstreaming process (i.e. Disability Sports Officers, Inclusion Officers, Integration Managers etc).

## WHAT DID WE LEARN?

The Overarching Outcome:
MAINSTREAMING is a WICKED PROBLEM

## WICKED PROBLEM

- Difficult or impossible to solve because of incomplete, contradictory, and changing requirements that are often difficult to recognize.
- It refers to an idea or problem that cannot be fixed, where there is no single solution to the problem;
- It has no determinable stopping point
- Because of complex interdependencies, the effort to solve one aspect of a wicked problem may reveal or create other problems.
